

Psalm 93

In the structure of this Psalm we note that verses 1, 3 and 4 describe situations, while verses 2 and 5 record testimonies.

As God's people dwell on the basic truths about the Creator God that they are drawn out in devotion and dedication.

Psalms 93:1 [New King James] *“The LORD reigns, He is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed, He has girded Himself with strength. Surely the world is established, so that it cannot be moved.”*

First stated there is the reigning God, majestic and mighty.

Secondly there is a stable earth, we are then invited to conclude that one leads to the other.

The stability of the created order on earth is dependent on the strength of the ruling Creator God, [Colossians 1:12-17] all the universe is held together by the power and authority of Jesus Christ the Son of God, its Creator.

Psalms 93:2 [New King James] *“Your throne is established from of old; You are from everlasting.”*

The throne of our Creator God has always existed and is eternal, [John 1:1-3, 14].

As the people of God know Jesus Christ personally, through His visit to this earth as a human being, we can ascribe strength and stability where it belongs and to Whom it belongs.

We throw in our lot with the unseen power of God by faith.

Hebrews 11:1-3 [New King James] *“Now faith is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen. For by it the elders obtained a good testimony. By faith we understand that the worlds were framed by the word of God, so that the things which are seen were not made of things which are visible.”*

The physical created earth that is stable is the substance we see as evidence of a God we cannot now, at this time, see, [Romans 1:18-22].

If we cannot accept and have faith in such an invisible God then He is angry with us and calls us foolish.

Psalms 93:3-4 [New King James] *“The floods have lifted up, O LORD, the floods have lifted up their voice; the floods lift up their waves. The LORD on high is mightier than the noise of many waters, than the mighty waves of the sea.”*

The “floods” typify the restless fretfulness of humanity against the Creator God, [Psalms 46:3; Luke 21:25-26], but they can avail nothing against the Creator God whose is more powerful and in honour lifted high above their influence.

Psalms 93:5 [New King James] *“Your testimonies are very sure; Holiness adorns Your house, O LORD, forever.”*

The reaction of the people of God, again addressing Him directly, is recorded.

Since God rules over all the physical earth, the people of God, true Christians today, acknowledge that He rules over them also.

The Creator God's testimonies, His Word, the Christian Bible, tells His people what is expected of them.

The testimonies are sure, stating His will perfectly and based on His perfect wisdom, compassion, love and faithfulness.

These are the basic requirements of those who are admitted into the fellowship of His house of holiness, a requirement that He will never relax but will stand for eternity.
