

Psalm 100

Psalms 100:1-2 [New King James] *“Make a joyful shout to the LORD, all you lands! Serve the LORD with gladness; come before His presence with singing.”*

The theme of Jesus Christ’s Kingship reaches its climax in the invitation given to all humanity to enter into the blessed relationship which Israel already possesses as God’s people, which includes all true Christians, [1 Peter 2:9-10].

Psalms 100:3 [New King James] *“Know that the LORD, He is God; it is He who has made us, and not we ourselves; we are His people and the sheep of His pasture.”*

This is central to our Christian life.

Jesus Christ is our Creator, [John 1:1-3, 14]. Our parents did not give us human life! The “human” spirit in us that makes us human, not animal, was given by God [Zechariah 12:1] and returns to God when we die, [Ecclesiastes 12:6-7; Acts 7:59].

Job 32:8 [New King James] *“But there is a spirit in man, and the breath of the Almighty gives him understanding.”*

This is the “human” spirit in every human being that allows us to think, plan and make decisions, [1 Corinthians 2:11] and through which the Holy Spirit works, [Proverbs 20:27].

Being devoid of this “human” spirit causes us to revert to animal life, [Daniel 4:24-37].

Only when we accept that our life is totally dependent on our Creator, Jesus Christ, can we begin a balanced relationship with Him as our Saviour and Lord, [John 15:5].

Colossians 1:15-16 [New King James] *“He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. For by Him all things were created that are in heaven and that are on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or dominions or principalities or powers. All things were created through Him and for Him.”*

Speaking of Jesus Christ, “all things” includes all human beings, do **not** read over the last three words, “and for Him.”

Humans were created by God to bring Him glory, [Matthew 5:14-16; John 15:8].

The second important fact for every true Christian and eventually every human being who has ever existed must know and accept is that human beings are like sheep, that tend to follow other sheep and not the Shepherd, who is Jesus Christ, [John 10:11-16].

Psalms 100:4 [New King James] *“Enter into His gates with thanksgiving, and into His courts with praise. Be thankful to Him, and bless His name.”*

All the above is a very good reason for us to praise and thank the Creator God for Who He is and what He has done for all humanity.

Psalms 100:5 [New King James] *“For the LORD is good; His mercy is everlasting, and His truth endures to all generations.”*

Thankfully our Creator God’s love [goodness] and mercy are like His Word, the Christian Bible, the truth, [John 17:17] are like His faithfulness to His Word, are eternal.

Available eventually to every generation of human beings who have ever existed, including all who have been blinded by Satan, who up to now has been allowed by God to control society, [1 John 5:19] and blind the vast majority of human beings to the good news that Jesus Christ brought from God the Father, [2 Corinthians 4:4] by inventing false religions and false ministers of religion, [2 Corinthians 11:14-15].

All this deception will come to an end at the time of Jesus Christ's Second Coming, [Revelation 20:1-6; 11-13].

This fact is something to thank God for, in advance, every day.
