

Psalm 125

Most people in society today are drawn towards anything that is “new” which makes them inconsistent and therefore unreliable.

True consistency is only found when we trust in the Creator God and His Word, the Christian Bible, both of which are eternal.

Psalms 125:1-2 [New King James] *“Those who trust in the LORD are like Mount Zion, which cannot be moved, but abides forever. As the mountains surround Jerusalem, so the LORD surrounds His people from this time forth and forever.”*

It is the deep conviction of security that the Psalmist finds in the unchanging Creator God, His power and faithfulness that finds its expression of this Psalm.

The Creator God cannot be shaken by the changes in our world brought about by human thought, new ideas as to why we exist, all of which leave a Creator God out of the picture or context.

The major and most dangerous of these “new” ideas is “discoveries” that are supposed to prove evolution that does not need a Creator God.

Understanding that evolution is a major tool in the hands of Satan who is seeking to blind us to the reason that human beings exist, [2 Corinthians 4:4]. To understand that Satan is a liar, trying to murder every human being, [John 8:44] will help us to have the deep conviction that the Psalmist had in the eternal nature of the Creator God and His Word, the Christian Bible.

Psalms 125:3 [New King James] *“For the sceptre of wickedness shall not rest on the land allotted to the righteous, lest the righteous reach out their hands to iniquity.”*

Satan’s rule over the world will come to an end, [**Revelation 20:1-3**] as soon as every generation of human beings have experienced how painful life is under his rule, [**1 John 5:19**] and seek to be subject to the loving rule and compassion of the all-powerful Creator God.

Helped by those who in this life have, in each generation, trusted in the Creator God, [**Revelation 20:4-6, 11-13**] having overcome the influence of Satan, [**Revelation 12:9-12**] by accepting the blood sacrifice of Jesus Christ and being a “light” to their generation, [**Matthew 5:14-16**].

Psalms 125:4 [New King James] *“Do good, O LORD, to those who are good, and to those who are upright in their hearts.”*

The Creator God is righteousness itself, it is His very nature, and He will bless all who seek to reflect His righteousness in their character, through following in the footsteps of the Holy Spirit as He produces in us the very character of the Triune God.

Galatians 5:22-25 [New King James] *“But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ’s have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit.”*

These “fruits” of this spiritual union with the Holy Spirit will only be produced if we have totally surrendered our lives to the Creator God.

Romans 12:1 [NIV] *“Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God, this is your spiritual act of worship.”*

The Greek word translated “bodies” is “soma” meaning whole life, physical body, mind and “human” spirit, [**Job 32:8; 1 Corinthians 2:11; Proverbs 20:27**].

Romans 12:2 [NIV] *“Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is, his good, pleasing and perfect will.”*

Only when we make this “living sacrifice” to show our gratitude to God the Father for what He has done for all humanity through His Son, Jesus Christ, [John 3:16-17; 1 Corinthians 15:3-4] will the Holy Spirit begin to re-educate us.

Psalms 125:5 [New King James] *“As for such as turn aside to their crooked ways, the LORD shall lead them away with the workers of iniquity. Peace be upon Israel!”*

This blessing of being freed from the penalty of our sins, [**Romans 6:23**] is **not** without our doing our part, the discipline of making right moral choices in our lives.

If we turn back to our old ways, we will join all who have never sought to obey God’s way of life.

2 Peter 2:20-22 [New King James] *“For if, after they have escaped the pollutions of the world through the knowledge of the Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ, they are again entangled in them and overcome, the latter end is worse for them than the beginning. For it would have been better for them not to have known the way of righteousness, than having known it, to turn from the holy commandment delivered to them. But it has happened to them according to the true proverb: ‘A dog returns to his own vomit,’ and, ‘a sow, having washed, to her wallowing in the mire.’”*

This is how the Creator God sees us if we go back to our old way of life, not a pleasant sight!
