

Psalm 133

This Psalm is about the family unity of God's people and how that coming together at an annual Feast Day such as the Feast of Tabernacles strengthens that feeling of family, [verse 1].

Psalms 133:2-3 [New King James] *“It is like the precious oil upon the head, running down on the beard, the beard of Aaron, running down on the edge of his garments. It is like the dew of Hermon, descending upon the mountains of Zion; for there the LORD commanded the blessing, life forevermore.”*

Oil has the general significance of joy, [Psalms 23:5; Psalms 104:15] with the related idea of fragrance, [Song of Solomon 1:3] and comfort, [Isaiah 1:6; Luke 10:34].

The abundance of the anointing oil, [verse 2] suggests how abundantly the Creator God blesses and sanctifies His people through their fellowship.

The main idea of “*dew*” expresses divine refreshment, God's gift of life and fruitfulness like the giving of manna in the wilderness, [Exodus 16:14].

When this is linked with Hermon and Zion indicates that the Creator God gives His gifts to His people when they are in fellowship.

1 John 3:14 [New King James] *“We know that we have passed from death to life, because we love the brethren. He who does not love his brother abides in death.”*

This love for and fellowship with God's people is proof that we have passed from eternal death to eternal life.

Unity in the Christian Church is important if it is to be a positive example to the rest of the world, and will give believers a foretaste of the world tomorrow after the Second Coming of Jesus Christ and the created family of God, the Kingdom [family grown up] of God.

The key to this unity is the Word of God, the Christian Bible, this must be the only standard by which ever decision is made.
