

Jesus Christ Is Immutable

One area of thinking that needs reform, that is because the changes that have taken place in society since Jesus Christ was here on earth means that God needs to modify His plans for His Church and humanity.

In effect, protestant leaders say that the Word of God, the Christian Bible, must be interpreted in the light of new developments.

A book that was written in the day when people rode donkeys must be reinterpreted to mesh with contemporary society.

The Christian Bible is outmoded and largely irrelevant.

Irrelevant means it doesn't relate to anything in this present society.

Outmoded means we have new modes of thinking and living now, so the Christian Bible is out of date.

We must, therefore, reassess its teachings and rethink our beliefs and hopes.

I am not overstating this at all. This is what is being taught in schools and universities and by newspapers.

The apostles and prophets had ideas that were good and advanced for their day but society is far more advanced today.

I challenge the idea that we are advanced.

I know that the majority of modern educators, newspaper writers, TV personalities, politicians and all the rest do **not** agree with me.

Nevertheless, I challenge the idea that we are any further advanced than they were in the days of Jesus Christ and the inspired writing of the Christian Bible.

Why are thousands of human beings killed each year with automobiles? It is because in this high speed society we don't ride donkeys because we are so advanced?

If we are so advanced why are we hard pressed to build more prisons because the present ones are overcrowded and our mental hospitals are overcrowded?

If we are so advanced, why is it that people cannot walk alone safely in parks anymore?

Why is it that workers who finish at midnight cannot walk home alone safely any more?

Why is it, if this is an advanced age, that drugs, violence, abortion and divorce are soaring out of hand?

This is a mindset that thinks whenever you move in a straight line you are going forward, forgetting that you can move in a straight line and be going in the wrong direction!

One tragedy of the present day is that protestant churches have accepted all this as progress.

The children of the protestant reformation have been brainwashed and indoctrinated by those who believe that changes in society have made a difference in God's Plan for humanity, in Christianity and even in Jesus Christ the Son of God.

The major advanced scientific teaching is, that if there is a Creator God, He used evolution to bring about the world and universe as we now see it.

Another prominent tragedy in the protestant churches is that they feel to maintain growth in numbers they must make adjustments, forgetting that the world has always been blessed by the people who as Christians were **not** adjusted to this world.

John 17:14-19 [NIV] *"I have given them your word and the world has hated them, for they are not of the world any more than I am of the world. My prayer is not that you take them out of the world but that you protect them from the evil one. They are not of the world, even as I am not of it. Sanctify them by the truth; your word is truth. As you sent me into the world, I have sent them into the world. For them I sanctify myself, that they too may be truly sanctified."*

The original disciples, as a result of the teaching of their Master Jesus Christ, were **not** to adjust to the world around them, even if it brought on them persecution.

Jesus Christ was the most immutable person in His generation.

He never pretended to adjust to the world.

Jesus Christ came to die for the world and to call the world to adjust to His teaching and lifestyle.

The contemporary world is the result of radical changes down the generations amounting to a revolution, a scientific revolution, the industrial revolution, the communications revolution, the philosophical and social revolutions.

These revolutions were mostly to draw people away from belief in the Creator God and His Word, the Christian Bible.

God Himself has not changed.

Hebrews 13:8 [NIV] *"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and for ever."*

This means His teaching has **not** changed nor the plan that God has for humanity.

Titus 1:2 [NIV] *"a faith and knowledge resting on the hope of eternal life, which God, who does not lie, promised before the beginning of time,"*

What God has said and commanded has **not** changed else God would have lied when He first said it.

Malachi 3:6-7 [NIV] *"I the LORD do not change. So you, O descendants of Jacob, are not destroyed. Ever since the time of your forefathers you have turned away from my decrees and have not kept them. Return to me, and I will return to you," says the LORD Almighty. 'But you ask, "How are we to return?"'"*

It is humanity that has changed by turning their back on the Creator God.

2 Peter 3:9 [NIV] *"The Lord is not slow in keeping his promise, as some understand slowness. He is patient with you, not wanting anyone to perish, but everyone to come to repentance."*

God desires that all humanity will turn around and adjust their lives to fit in with His lifestyle grounded in love and faithfulness.

Luke 1:37 [NIV] *"For nothing is impossible with God."*

The very birth of Jesus Christ as the Son of Man was a miracle.

Luke 18:27 [NIV] *“Jesus replied, ‘What is impossible with men is possible with God.’”*

As the creator of the whole universe God is **not** limited in any way what He can do.

Matthew 19:26 [NIV] *“Jesus looked at them and said, ‘With man this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.’”*

As a result of these promises of Jesus Christ the Son of God, I believe in miracles.

The miracles of both the Old and New Testaments were real.

I believe that whatever the Creator God wants to do anything that is out of the ordinary and contrary to or at least above the common processes of His creation, He is able to do it.

True Christians are people who refuse to adjust to this world’s society but seek to make the world adjust to the Creator God’s way of life.

Revelation 19:11-16 [NIV] *“I saw heaven standing open and there before me was a white horse, whose rider is called Faithful and True. With justice he judges and makes war. His eyes are like blazing fire, and on his head are many crowns. He has a name written on him that no-one knows but he himself. He is dressed in a robe dipped in blood, and his name is the Word of God. The armies of heaven were following him, riding on white horses and dressed in fine linen, white and clean. Out of his mouth comes a sharp sword with which to strike down the nations. ‘He will rule them with an iron sceptre.’ He treads the winepress of the fury of the wrath of God Almighty. On his robe and on his thigh he has this name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.”*

This is the all-powerful Creator God whom I worship, who is going to come back to earth, this time to rule this doubting world.

All people will adjust to His will or die eternally.

True Christians will **not** surrender to this world’s puny leaders [physical or spiritual] when we have a Master with such power and majesty.

A Creator God who will **not** adjust to any mere humans or nations who are but dust in the balance to Him, [Isaiah 40:15].
