

How Will Jesus Christ Rule The World Tomorrow After His Second Coming?

Great statesmen and leading scientists have openly stated that humanity's only hope for world peace lies in world government. One universal government wielding supreme power and authority over all nations.

But these same leaders also admit that the nations could never bring about a world-ruling government. Agreement on who would rule and how they would rule would be utterly impossible.

Yet God's Word, the Christian Bible, prophecy tells us that world government will soon be established.

Jesus Christ is returning to this earth in Person, this time to restore and administer the government of God on earth, a fulfilment of the prayer outline that Jesus Christ taught His disciples, [Matthew 6:10].

Exactly how will Jesus Christ create and maintain world peace on His return?

This article aims to answer this question as we study several basic scriptures describing what Jesus Christ's government will be like in the world tomorrow after His Second Coming.

Where did Jesus Christ go after His resurrection?

Romans 8:34 [New King James] *“Who is he who condemns? It is Christ who died, and furthermore is also risen, who is even at the right hand of God, who also makes intercession for us.”*

From this position Jesus Christ is preparing people to work with Him after His Second Coming, just as John the Baptist did for His First Coming, [John 1:23].

John 14:1-3 [New King James] *“Let not your heart be troubled; you believe in God, believe also in Me. In My Father's house are many mansions; if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again and receive you to Myself; that where I am, there you may be also.”*

When Jesus says, “My Father's house” He was referring to the temple in Jerusalem, in this building where many rooms that temple officials used when on duty. He was indicating to His disciples that such positions of authority would be prepared for them when He was at His Father's Throne.

The Greek word translated “mansions” is “mōnē” from the root word “mēnō” meaning state, relationship, expectancy.

How long will Jesus Christ remain in heaven before He returns to earth?

Acts 3:20-21 [NIV] *“and that he may send the Christ, who has been appointed for you, even Jesus. He must remain in heaven until the time comes for God to restore everything, as he promised long ago through his holy prophets.”*

This time for God to “restore all things” again refers to the will of God being done on earth as in heaven, [Matthew 6:10].

Matthew 24:36 [New King James] *“But of that day and hour no one knows, not even the angels of heaven, but My Father only.”*

Only God the Father knows when the time will be perfect for Jesus Christ's Second Coming. But notice the context in which this is stated by Jesus Christ, and what will be happening on earth in the generation that will experience Jesus Christ's return.

How will Jesus Christ begin to rule on earth?

Revelation 19:11-16 [New King James] *“Now I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse. And He who sat on him was called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and makes war. His eyes were like a flame of fire, and on His head were many crowns. He had a name written that no one knew except Himself. He was clothed with a robe dipped in blood, and His name is called The Word of God. And the armies in heaven, clothed in fine linen, white and clean, followed Him on white horses. Now out of His mouth goes a sharp sword, that with it He should strike the nations. And He Himself will rule them with a rod of iron. He Himself treads the winepress of the fierceness and wrath of Almighty God. And He has on His robe and on His thigh a name written: KING OF KINGS AND LORD OF LORDS.”*

A very dramatic return of Jesus Christ this time to rule as *“King of kings and Lord of lords.”*

The “rod of iron” is symbolic of absolute authority, humans being made to submit to the *“Word of God,”* Jesus Christ in person, [John 14:6; John 17:17], and the *“Word of God”* as recorded in the Christian Bible, [Hebrews 4:12].

This rule of Jesus Christ will start with a much-depleted humanity, [Revelation 8:11; Revelation 9:15, 18; Revelation 11:13; Revelation 13:15; Revelation 14:17-20; Revelation 19:21].

Revelation 20:5 [New King James] *“But the rest of the dead did not live again until the thousand years were finished. This is the first resurrection.”*

They will come back to physical life in a transformed world after 1,000 years of the rule of Jesus Christ, [Revelation 20:11-13].

Where will Jesus Christ's throne and headquarters be?

Jeremiah 3:17 [New King James] *“At that time Jerusalem shall be called The Throne of the LORD, and all the nations shall be gathered to it, to the name of the LORD, to Jerusalem. No more shall they follow the dictates of their evil hearts.”*

“At that time” refers to the time of Jesus Christ's Second Coming.

This coming government will **not** be a democracy.

Government will be from the top, God the Father and Jesus Christ down.

From His headquarters in Jerusalem Christ's rule will spread eventually over the whole earth.

Who will assist Jesus Christ in His rule?

Revelation 20:4 [New King James] *“And I saw thrones, and they sat on them, and judgment was committed to them. Then I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded for their witness to Jesus and for the word of God, who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received his mark on their foreheads or on their hands. And they lived and reigned with Christ for a thousand years.”*

All who had remained faithful to Jesus Christ, even to death. True Christians in whom the Holy Spirit was active [Romans 8:9] developing the very character of the Creator, as *“fruits”* of the Holy Spirit as they follow His guide [Galatians 5:22-25].

These are the people who will be ruling under Jesus Christ after His Second Coming and they're now resurrected into a spirit body, [1 Corinthians 15:50-58; 1 Thessalonians 4:13-17].

Will these people be rulers over cities?

Luke 19:12-19 [New King James] *“Therefore He said: ‘A certain nobleman went into a far country to receive for himself a kingdom and to return. So he called ten of his servants, delivered to them ten minas, and said to them, “Do business till I come.” But his citizens hated him, and sent a delegation after him, saying, “We will not have this man to reign over us.” And so it was that when he returned, having received the kingdom, he then commanded these servants, to whom he had given the money, to be called to him, that he might know how much every man had gained by trading. Then came the first, saying, “Master, your mina has earned ten minas.” And he said to him, “Well done, good servant; because you were faithful in a very little, have authority over ten cities.” And the second came, saying, “Master, your mina has earned five minas.” Likewise he said to him, “You also be over five cities.””*

The words of Jesus Christ in context with the Kingdom of God and His Second Coming.

As the above article based on God’s Word, the Christian Bible, the cities in the world tomorrow will be very different to what we understand as cities in today’s society.

The approach of these rulers, [“kings and priests” – **Revelation 1:6**] will be very different to rulers in human societies.

Matthew 20:25-28 [New King James] *“But Jesus called them to Himself and said, ‘You know that the rulers of the Gentiles lord it over them, and those who are great exercise authority over them. Yet it shall not be so among you; but whoever desires to become great among you, let him be your servant. And whoever desires to be first among you, let him be your slave, just as the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life a ransom for many.’”*

The approach is one of a servant to rule in a way that will bring blessings to those they rule over.

This is a way of life true Christians should be learning now to prepare them for the world tomorrow under Jesus Christ’

Philippians 2:1-5 [New King James] *“Therefore if there is any consolation in Christ, if any comfort of love, if any fellowship of the Spirit, if any affection and mercy, fulfil my joy by being like-minded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Let nothing be done through selfish ambition or conceit, but in lowliness of mind let each esteem others better than himself. Let each of you look out not only for his own interests, but also for the interests of others. Let this mind be in you which was also in Christ Jesus,”*

The mind of Jesus Christ is depicted here as the mind of a servant who has great concern for human beings.

Romans 12:1-2 [NIV] *“Therefore, I urge you, brothers, in view of God’s mercy, to offer your bodies as living sacrifices, holy and pleasing to God, this is your spiritual act of worship. Do not conform any longer to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God’s will is, his good, pleasing and perfect will.”*

Part of the training that true Christians should seek now to prepare for the future is to surrender their lives totally to God, out of gratitude for what He has done for all humanity through the birth, life, death and resurrection of His Son Jesus Christ.

Then allow the active indwelling Holy Spirit re-educate us to think and act like our Saviour Jesus Christ, not then being influenced by today's Satan-controlled society, [1 John 5:19].

One major ability all the priests and kings under Jesus Christ will have –

Isaiah 30:20-21 [New King James] *“And though the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, yet your teachers will not be moved into a corner anymore, but your eyes shall see your teachers. Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, ‘This is the way, walk in it,’ whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left.”*

Refers directly to the ability of teachers who live in spirit bodies, able to appear suddenly, as Jesus Christ the Son of Man did after His resurrection, [John 20:19, 26].

This personal teaching will not be restrained by Satan's influence, [Revelation 20:1-3].

How successful will these priest-teachers be in teaching the knowledge of God's way of life?

Jeremiah 31:31-34 [New King James] *“Behold, the days are coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and with the house of Judah, not according to the covenant that I made with their fathers in the day that I took them by the hand to lead them out of the land of Egypt, My covenant which they broke, though I was a husband to them, says the LORD. But this is the covenant that I will make with the house of Israel after those days, says the LORD: I will put My law in their minds, and write it on their hearts; and I will be their God, and they shall be My people. No more shall every man teach his neighbour, and every man his brother, saying, ‘Know the LORD,’ for they all shall know Me, from the least of them to the greatest of them, says the LORD. For I will forgive their iniquity, and their sin I will remember no more.”*

As the deception of Satan will be restrained [2 Corinthians 4:4] all living human beings will eventually come to know God's Great Plan for all humanity.

Genesis 1:26-27 [New King James] *“Then God said, ‘Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth.’ So God created man in His own image; in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.”*

The two different Hebrew words used in this original recorded statement of God's reason for creating human beings, show us a two-part plan, that is still under way and on into world tomorrow.

“Image” the Hebrew word “*tselem*” meaning resemblance, shadow or outward form.

“Likeness” the Hebrew word “*demûwth*” meaning manner, attributes, model or character.

Note that all humans were and are created in the “image” of God but **not** the “likeness.”

Character can only be formed through a period of time spent in the presence of the One whose “likeness” we wish to reflect.

This is only accomplished through the active indwelling of the Holy Spirit over a period of time, hence human physical life, [Jeremiah 31:31-33; Galatians 5:22-25].

Revelation 20:11-13 [New King James] *“Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat on it, from whose face the earth and the heaven fled away. And there was found no place for them. And I saw the dead, small and great, standing before God, and books were opened. And another book was opened, which is the Book of Life. And the dead were judged according to their works, by the things which were written in the books. The sea gave up the dead who were in it, and Death and Hades delivered up the dead who were in them. And they were judged, each one according to his works.”*

Eventually all humans who have **never** heard of Jesus Christ as their Saviour nor God's Word, the Christian Bible, will be resurrected back to physical life in a world that is devoid of Satan's deception and full of well-trained "*kings and priests*" to teach them God's way of life.

These people will also be offered eternal life if they are willing to yield to the Creator God and learn to love and worship Him.

Romans 6:23 [New King James] "*For the wages of sin is death, but the gift of God is eternal life in Christ Jesus our Lord.*"

Eternal life is a gift from God, it **cannot** be earned through religious acts of righteousness.

John 17:3 [New King James] "*And this is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.*"

It will be a time in which all human beings can, through an intimate relationship, come to know God the Father and Jesus Christ more fully, this will take eternity.

1 John 5:11-12 [New King James] "*And this is the testimony: that God has given us eternal life, and this life is in His Son. He who has the Son has life; he who does not have the Son of God does not have life.*"

The beginning of this eternal life can start for any human being **now** as we allow the Son of God into our lives to direct every part of that life.

I hope now that when we read and meditate of **Matthew 6:10** we will now be praying for that time with greater desire.
