

Teachers In The World Tomorrow

Revelation 5:10 [New King James] *“And have made us kings and priests to our God; and we shall reign on the earth.”*

True Christians recognise from scripture that their work with Jesus Christ will be leaders and teachers under Jesus Christ, [Revelation 1:4-6; Revelation 20:4; 1 Peter 2:9; Daniel 7:27].

1 Corinthians 6:1-2 [NIV] *“If any of you has a dispute with another, dare he take it before the ungodly for judgment instead of before the saints? Do you not know that the saints will judge the world? And if you are to judge the world, are you not competent to judge trivial cases?”*

This scripture clearly tells us that we are to prepare now for that future job of work.

Did not Jesus Christ tell us that we are not to judge one another?

Matthew 7:1-2 [NIV] *“Do not judge, or you too will be judged. For in the same way as you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to you.”*

Notice it tells us that there is a **“way of judging”!**

Where can we learn this correct way of judging?

Isaiah 30:20 [New King James] *“And though the Lord gives you the bread of adversity and the water of affliction, yet your teachers will not be moved into a corner anymore, but your eyes shall see your teachers.”*

This verse refers in prophecy to the tribulation that will come on all humanity prior to the Second Coming of Jesus Christ, [**Matthew 24:21-22**] and what will happen to all who survive this tribulation.

Their re-education will be on a local basis.

Isaiah 30:19 [New King James] *“For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem; you shall weep no more. He will be very gracious to you at the sound of your cry; when He hears it, He will answer you.”*

Jesus Christ will be merciful to these people who have survived this tribulation.

They have come out of a world that has shattered all their hopes.

Let down by the leaders, secular and spiritual, they had trusted.

All they had worked for had ended in rubble.

Their generation had become devoid of real parental guidance and love.

2 Timothy 3:1-5 [New King James] *“But know this, that in the last days perilous times will come: For men will be lovers of themselves, lovers of money, boasters, proud, blasphemers, disobedient to parents, unthankful, unholy, unloving, unforgiving, slanderers, without self-control, brutal, despisers of good, traitors, headstrong, haughty, lovers of pleasure rather than lovers of God, having a form of godliness but denying its power. And from such people turn away!”*

A vivid description of this present generation.

Isaiah 30:21 [New King James] *“Your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, ‘This is the way, walk in it,’ whenever you turn to the right hand or whenever you turn to the left.”*

When we first read this remedy it seems to be very “regimental” but the King James hides the depth of meaning in the words used.

“*This is the way*” – the Hebrew word translated “way” is “*derek*” meaning a course of life or mode of action, a lead that can **only** be truly shown by personal example of leader, who is living right there with them.

“*Turn*” is Hebrew word “*nâtâh*” meaning to bend towards, stretch towards and have a desire for.

The result of seeing the leader’s example.

“*Right*” – Hebrew word “*aman*” meaning to look for support, a desire to have someone you can trust, be it at home with, feel a sense of warmth and love.

This is exactly what such disillusioned people will desire.

“*Left*” – Hebrew “*semôl*” meaning get wrapped up by, totally involved in this new right “*peer*” pressure, wanting to belong to this new group of people.

When we understand the real meaning of these verses we can see how the message of this new way of life will spread and many will seek to become a part of it.

Zechariah 8:20-23 [New King James] *“Thus says the LORD of hosts: ‘Peoples shall yet come, inhabitants of many cities; the inhabitants of one city shall go to another, saying, ‘Let us continue to go and pray before the LORD, and seek the LORD of hosts. I myself will go also.’ Yes, many peoples and strong nations shall come to seek the LORD of hosts in Jerusalem, and to pray before the LORD.’ Thus says the LORD of hosts: ‘In those days ten men from every language of the nations shall grasp the sleeve of a Jewish man, saying, ‘Let us go with you, for we have heard that God is with you.’””*

The word “*Jew*” refers to one who is one inwardly by the indwelling of the Holy Spirit, [**Romans 8:9; Romans 2:28-29**] that is a Christian.

Such recognition and credibility has to be learnt and earned.

Matthew 5:14-16 [New King James] *“You are the light of the world. A city that is set on a hill cannot be hidden. Nor do they light a lamp and put it under a basket, but on a lampstand, and it gives light to all who are in the house. Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.”*

This is then the way we should be living now in this physical life.

1 Timothy 3:7 [New King James] *“Moreover he must have a good testimony among those who are outside, lest he fall into reproach and the snare of the devil.”*

These people may be the very ones that God preserves through the tribulation to be the “*first fruits*” of our work under Jesus Christ after His Second Coming.
